

Roy McConkey is Emeritus Professor of Developmental Disabilities at Ulster University and visiting Professor at the University of Cape Town, South Africa and at Trinity College, Dublin

He has worked in the field of intellectual disability for over 40 years and has authored, co-authored and edited over 15 books, and published nearly 200 book chapters and research papers in learned journals. He has acted as a consultant to various United Nations agencies and International NGOs. This work has taken him to some 25 countries in Eastern Europe, Africa, Asia, South America.

Currently he is a consultant to Special Olympics International and is involved in the global evaluation of their Unified Sports and Healthy Communities programmes. In Ireland, he has been involved in the evaluation of personalised accommodation and support arrangements for persons with disabilities which were grant-aided by Genio Trust. He has advised the Health Services Executive on information systems and is working with the Health Research Board on longitudinal analyses of service provision for persons with intellectual disabilities.

His latest book, published in 2016 and co-edited with Edurne Garcia-Iriarte and Robbie Gilligan, is entitled *Disability and Human Rights: Global Perspectives*
